S.F. 2171 adopts new districts for the Metropolitan Council. Minn. Stat. §473.123, subd. 3a, requires the legislature to conduct redistricting for the Council after the decennial census. The new districts are to be effective in a year ending in "3."

Section 1 [District boundaries] references the plan that includes the new Metropolitan Council districts. The plan is adopted and constitutes the districts going forward. The plan is available here: <u>https://www.gis.lcc.mn.gov/redist2020/mcplans2023.html</u>.

Section 2 [Application] specifies that this act applies in the seven-county metropolitan area.

Section 3 [Repealer] repeals the previous Metropolitan Council redistricting plan.

Section 4 [Effective date] provides an immediate effective date.
