

1.1 Senator moves to amend S.F. No. 2732 as follows:

1.2 Page 8, after line 24, insert:

1.3 "Sec. 6. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 10A.273, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.4 Subdivision 1. **Contributions during legislative session.** (a) A candidate for the
1.5 legislature or for constitutional office, the candidate's principal campaign committee, or a
1.6 political committee or party unit established by all or a part of the party organization within
1.7 a house of the legislature, must not solicit or accept a contribution from a registered lobbyist,
1.8 political committee, political fund, or an association not registered with the board during a
1.9 regular session of the legislature.

1.10 (b) During a regular session of the legislature, a candidate for the legislature or for
1.11 constitutional office, or the candidate's principal campaign committee, must not solicit
1.12 contributions for or take an action directly related to the solicitation or acceptance of
1.13 contributions for a political party or party unit from a registered lobbyist, political committee,
1.14 political fund, or an association not registered with the board.

1.15 (c) A registered lobbyist, political committee, political fund, or an association not
1.16 registered with the board must not make a contribution to a candidate for the legislature or
1.17 for constitutional office, the candidate's principal campaign committee, or a political
1.18 committee or party unit established by all or a part of the party organization within a house
1.19 of the legislature during a regular session of the legislature.

1.20 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.

1.21 Sec. 7. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 10A.273, subdivision 2, is amended to read:

1.22 Subd. 2. **Party and party unit solicitations.** (a) At an event hosted by a candidate, a
1.23 political party or party unit must not solicit or receive ~~at an event hosted by a candidate for~~
1.24 ~~the legislature or by a candidate for constitutional office~~ a contribution from a lobbyist,
1.25 political committee, political fund, or party unit during a regular session of the legislature.

1.26 (b) A political party or party unit must not use the image of a candidate or promote the
1.27 attendance of a candidate at an event to solicit contributions during the legislative session.

1.28 (c) For purposes of this subdivision, "candidate" means a candidate for the legislature
1.29 or for constitutional office.

1.30 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment."
