1.4 "Sec. 23. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 10A.15, subdivision 3, is amended to read:

1.5 Subd. 3. **Deposit.** All contributions received by or on behalf of a candidate, principal
1.6 campaign committee, political committee, political fund, or party unit must be ~~deposited in~~
1.7 ~~an~~ placed in a depository account designated "Campaign Fund of (name of candidate,
1.8 committee, fund, or party unit)." All contributions must be deposited promptly upon receipt
1.9 and, except for contributions received during the last three days of a reporting period as
1.10 described in section 10A.20, must be deposited during the reporting period in which they
1.11 were received. A contribution ~~received during the last three days of a reporting period must~~
1.12 ~~be deposited within 72 hours after receipt and must be reported as received during the~~
1.13 ~~reporting period whether or not deposited within that period~~ must not be deposited in any
1.14 other account prior to being deposited within a depository of the principal campaign
1.15 committee, political committee, political fund, or party unit. However, a contribution may
1.16 temporarily be held within a digital wallet or other account immediately after receipt if the
1.17 recipient principal campaign committee, political committee, political fund, or party unit
1.18 has sole ownership of that account. A candidate, principal campaign committee, political
1.19 committee, political fund, or party unit may refuse to accept a contribution. A deposited
1.20 contribution may be returned to the contributor within 90 days after deposit. A contribution
1.21 deposited and not returned within 90 days after that deposit must be reported as accepted."

1.22 Page 18, after line 18, insert:

1.23 "Sec. 26. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 10A.15, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.24 to read:

1.25 Subd. 9. **Mobile payments.** (a) A principal campaign committee, political committee,
1.26 political fund, or party unit may accept a contribution of money made using a mobile payment
1.27 service or platform, a service that is dependent upon direct carrier billing, or a website.

1.28 (b) A principal campaign committee, political committee, political fund, or party unit
1.29 may not solicit or accept a contribution made using a mobile payment service or platform
1.30 that, to a potential contributor, displays only the name of an individual as the recipient or
1.31 displays a name for the recipient that is not substantially similar to the name under which
1.32 the recipient is registered with the board.

2.1 (c) A mobile payment contribution must be deposited pursuant to subdivision 3 before
2.2 the funds received may be used to make an expenditure or disbursement other than payment
2.3 of any processing fee charged for using the mobile payment service or platform.

2.4 Sec. 27. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 10A.17, subdivision 5, is amended to read:

2.5 Subd. 5. **Penalty.** A person who violates subdivision 2 or 6 is subject to a civil penalty
2.6 imposed by the board of up to \$1,000. A person who knowingly violates subdivision 3a or
2.7 4 or falsely claims that an expenditure was an independent expenditure is guilty of a gross
2.8 misdemeanor and subject to a civil penalty imposed by the board of up to \$3,000.

2.9 Sec. 28. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 10A.17, is amended by adding a subdivision to
2.10 read:

2.11 Subd. 6. **Use of depository.** A political committee, political fund, principal campaign
2.12 committee, or party unit may not expend money unless the expenditure or other disbursement
2.13 is made using petty cash or a depository of that committee, fund, or party unit."
