1.3 Page 10, line 6, after the period, insert "The reports must further include information
1.4 on:"

1.5 Page 10, after line 6, insert:

1.6 "(1) the ability of eligible energy technology to meet the average minimum amount of
1.7 electric power required by retail customers in Minnesota;

1.8 (2) the average cost per unit of electricity generated by each source of eligible energy
1.9 technology identified in subdivision 1, paragraph (c), to electric utilities and retail customers
1.10 in Minnesota; and

1.11 (3) the ability of eligible energy technologies to meet the required average minimum
1.12 amount of electric power and reduce the cost per unit to electric utilities and retail customers
1.13 in Minnesota."

1.14 Page 13, after line 14, insert:

1.15 "Sec. 17. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 216B.1691, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.16 to read:

1.17 Subd. 11. **Suspension of standard obligations.** The standard obligations under
1.18 subdivisions 2a, 2f, and 2g must be suspended, and electric utilities will not have any
1.19 obligation under those subdivisions, if, by January 1, 2030:

1.20 (1) eligible energy technology is unable to meet the average minimum amount of electric
1.21 power required by retail customers in Minnesota; or

1.22 (2) the average cost per unit of electricity generated by solar energy and wind energy to
1.23 electric utilities and retail customers in Minnesota is equal to or greater than the average
1.24 cost per unit on January 1, 2024."
