1.3 **S.F. No. 658:** A bill for an act relating to public utilities; providing a procedure to resolve
1.4 disputes between public utilities and residential customers; amending Minnesota Statutes
1.5 2022, section 216B.17, subdivision 1; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes,
1.6 chapter 216B.

1.7 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.8 Page 2, line 5, delete the first "the" and insert "a" and delete everything after "utility"
1.9 and insert a period

1.10 Page 2, delete line 6

1.11 Page 2, line 28, after the period, insert "Nothing in this section affects any other rights
1.12 existing under this chapter or other law."

1.13 Page 3, line 13, delete "commission" and after "proceeding" insert "before the
1.14 commission"

1.15 Page 3, line 14, delete everything after "issue" and insert "any procedural schedules,
1.16 notices, or orders required to initiate an informal proceeding or a contested case."

1.17 Page 3, delete line 15

1.18 And when so amended the bill do pass and be re-referred to the Committee on State and
1.19 Local Government and Veterans. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
