Dear Chair Frentz, Senator Port, and Committee Members,

On behalf of Clean Energy Economy MN (CEEM), I write today in support of SF1404 for a solar on public buildings grant program to be established in the Department of Commerce. We support this bill because it will create new market opportunities for Minnesota's solar industry, decrease energy costs for public buildings, and assist local governments in reaching their climate goals.
