1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 97A.465, subdivision 3, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 3. **Nonresidents stationed in state.** (a) The commissioner may issue a resident

1.8 license to take fish or game to a person in the armed forces of the United States that is

1.9 stationed in the state. This ~~subdivision~~ paragraph does not apply to the taking of moose or

1.10 elk.

1.11 (b) The commissioner may issue a resident angling license to a person in the armed

1.12 forces of the United States that is stationed in the state and to the spouse of a person in the

1.13 armed forces of the United States that is stationed in the state.
