

1.1 **Senator Hawj from the Committee on Environment, Climate, and Legacy, to which**  
1.2 **was referred**

1.3 **S.F. No. 31:** A bill for an act relating to natural resources; modernizing statutes related  
1.4 to the registration, transfer, and operation of snowmobiles, all-terrain vehicles, and  
1.5 off-highway motorcycles; amending Minnesota Statutes 2022, sections 84.788, subdivision  
1.6 5; 84.82, subdivision 2, by adding a subdivision; 84.821, subdivision 2; 84.84; 84.86,  
1.7 subdivision 1; 84.87, subdivision 1; repealing Minnesota Rules, parts 6100.5000, subparts  
1.8 3, 4, 5; 6100.5700, subpart 4.

1.9 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.10 Page 7, after line 11, insert:

1.11 "Sec. 8. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 84.922, subdivision 4, is amended to read:

1.12 Subd. 4. **Report of transfers.** (a) Application for transfer of ownership must be made  
1.13 to the commissioner within 15 days of the date of transfer.

1.14 (b) An application for transfer must be executed by the ~~registered~~ current owner and the  
1.15 purchaser using a bill of sale that includes the vehicle serial number.

1.16 (c) The purchaser is subject to the penalties imposed by section 84.774 if the purchaser  
1.17 fails to apply for transfer of ownership as provided under this subdivision."

1.18 Renumber the sections in sequence

1.19 Amend the title as follows:

1.20 Page 1, line 3, after "snowmobiles" insert ", all-terrain vehicles, and off-highway  
1.21 motorcycles"

1.22 Amend title numbers accordingly

1.23 And when so amended the bill do pass. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
