I have been involved with turtle conservation and research in Minnesota for 35 years. I have seen turtle populations decrease at a number of the sites where I have worked. I have worked with all the species found in Minnesota.

Turtle populations in Minnesota, the US, and the world have been under threat from habitat loss, pollution, and human use. Commercial harvest, especially of Snapping Turtles, targets adult females. The females are crucial for the maintenance and recovery of the turtle populations.

The initial efforts to eliminate commercial turtle harvest started 20 years ago with elimination of new turtle harvester licenses but allowed existing trappers to annually renew their licenses. It has been a long process to get Minnesota's turtles protected. I am looking forward to seeing commercial harvesting finally coming to an end.
