

1.1 **Senator Marty from the Committee on Finance, to which was re-referred**

1.2 **H.F. No. 4:** A bill for an act relating to transportation; modifying requirements for a
 1.3 noncompliant driver's license or Minnesota identification card and making related changes,
 1.4 including on eligibility, proof of lawful presence, primary and secondary documentation,
 1.5 and data practices; making technical changes; appropriating money; amending Minnesota
 1.6 Statutes 2022, sections 13.6905, by adding a subdivision; 168.327, subdivision 6; 171.04,
 1.7 subdivision 5; 171.06, subdivision 3, by adding subdivisions; 171.07, subdivisions 1, 3;
 1.8 171.12, subdivisions 7, 7a, 7b, 9, by adding a subdivision; proposing coding for new law
 1.9 in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 171; repealing Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 171.015,
 1.10 subdivision 7.

1.11 Reports the same back with the recommendation that H.F. No. 4, the first unofficial
 1.12 engrossment, be amended as follows:

1.13 Page 1, after line 18, insert:

1.14 "Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 171.06, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.15 Subdivision 1. **Application format and requirements.** Every application for a Minnesota
 1.16 identification card, including an enhanced identification card, or for a driver's license,
 1.17 including an instruction permit, a provisional license, a noncompliant driver's license, a
 1.18 REAL ID driver's license, and an enhanced driver's license, must be made in a format
 1.19 approved by the department. Every application must be accompanied by payment of the
 1.20 proper fee. All applicants must sign the application and declare, under penalty of perjury,
 1.21 that the information and documentation presented in the application is true and correct. All
 1.22 applications requiring evidence of legal presence in the United States or United States
 1.23 citizenship must be signed in the presence of the person authorized to accept the application,
 1.24 or the signature on the application may be verified by a notary public."

1.25 Page 3, line 17, delete ", under the penalty of perjury,"

1.26 Page 3, line 24, delete everything after "of" and insert "citizenship or immigration status
 1.27 if required by federal law."

1.28 Page 3, delete line 25

1.29 Renumber the sections in sequence

1.30 Amend the title numbers accordingly

1.31 And when so amended the bill do pass. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
