Dear Chair Fateh:

As the Program Director for the Minnesota Addiction Medicine Fellowship, I am writing to ask you to include \$270,000 in funding per year for the Addiction Medicine fellowship in

your omnibus bill. Our faculty at Hennepin County Medical Center, University of Minnesota, and the VAMC provide this critical expansion of the work force by training physicians in addiction. We were very disappointed that it was not included in the senate omnibus bill. You have been supportive of this bill and our efforts as the author of this legislation, and we sincerely request and urge you to reconsider and include this in the senate omnibus bill. We partner with several institutions and populations to serve those in rural and underserved areas and to serve those with co-occurring mental health, pain, and other serious health conditions.

Funding the fellowship has consistently been difficult; piecing together funding from different sources has limited the number of physicians we are able to train. Our recent fellows are serving the entire state of Minnesota by running Project ECHO's, treating patients in critical populations and locations around the state and becoming teachers and leaders.
