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## "Sec. 22. <u>DIRECTION TO COMMISSIONER OF HEALTH; KEEPING NURSES</u> AT THE BEDSIDE ACT IMPACT EVALUATION.

By October 1, 2023, the commissioner of health must contract with the commissioner of management and budget for the services of the Impact Evaluation Unit to design and implement a rigorous causal impact evaluation using time-series data or other evaluation methods as determined by the Impact Evaluation Unit to estimate the causal impact of the implementation of Minnesota Statutes, sections 144.7051 to 144.7059, on patient care, nurse job satisfaction, nurse retention, and other outcomes as determined by the commissioner and the Impact Evaluation Unit. The Impact Evaluation Unit may subcontract with other research organizations to assist with the design or implementation of the impact evaluation. By February 15, 2024, the commissioner of health must submit to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over health draft legislation specifying any additional authorities the commissioner and the Impact Evaluation Unit may require to collect the data required to conduct a successful impact evaluation of the implementation of Minnesota Statutes, sections 144.7051 to 144.7059. By October 1, 2024, the Impact Evaluation Unit must begin collecting baseline data. By June 30, 2027, the Impact Evaluation Unit must submit to the commissioner of health a public initial report on the status of the evaluation project and any preliminary results."
