Dear Chair Kunesh and Committee Members,

As the coalition behind the Hunger-Free Schools campaign, we are writing today to express support of SF123, which would provide no cost breakfast and lunch to all students in Minnesota. By ensuring that all schools in our state are Hunger-Free Schools, we can eliminate hunger in Minnesota's classrooms; eliminate stigma from the lunchroom; and reduce the paperwork strain that burdens Minnesotan families and schools.

In Minnesota, 1 in 4 food-insecure kids comes from a household whose income disqualifies them from accessing free or reduced-cost meals at school. For a state that prides itself in being an exceptional place to raise a family, this is unacceptable.

School breakfast and lunch can account for more than half of a child's daily calories, providing sustenance that they may not have reliable access to at home. School meals also help establish lifelong healthy eating habits, and can reduce the likelihood of chronic conditions like diabetes and heart disease developing later in life. Studies also show that school meal participation lessens the achievement gap and allows students to focus on what really matters when they're at school – learning.

Providing free school meals to all students is an investment in Minnesota's future. It supports student success, working parents, teachers and nutrition staff, and strengthens our state's foundation for a solid and sustainable future. We urge you to support SF123, which would provide today's students the support they need to grow into Minnesota's business leaders, parents, and legislators of tomorrow.
