1.11	(b) The African American Registry must use grant funds to develop a readability level
1.12	system and integrate the system into the African American Registry's Teacher's Forum in
1.13	order to help teachers and teacher candidates improve reading literacy comprehension. The
1.14	African American Registry must allow Minnesota teacher preparation institutions and K-12
1.15	schools to use the reading maturity metrics in the readability level system. By January 15,
1.16	2026, the African American Registry must submit to the legislature a detailed report
1.17	documenting how the grant funds were used.
