1.7	a district or charter school equals the greater of \$15 times the district's adjusted pupil units
1.8	for the school year or \$50,000.
1.9	Subd. 2. Uses of school library aid. School library aid must be reserved and used for
1.10	directly funding the costs of the following purposes within a library:
1.11	(1) the salaries and benefits of a school library media specialist;
1.12	(2) electronic, computer, and audiovisual equipment;
1.13	(3) information technology infrastructure and digital tools;

1.15	(5) furniture, equipment, or supplies.
