Hibbing High School

- Opened in 1924
- Cost to build: \$3.9 million
- Included features: 1,800 Seat Auditorium with Belgian crystal chandeliers, Indoor Pool, Greenhouse, marble finishes, terra-cotta statues, 60' long mural, frescoes on walls and ceilings.
- Challenges to maintain this active school on National Historic Register
