### **Bill Description**

House File 274-0 creates a commission to recommend to the legislature a redesign of state emblems, defined as the state seal and the state flag, by January 1, 2024. The bill requires the Minnesota Historical Society to "provide office space and administrative support to the commission." The bill also permits the commission to enlist volunteer help with design of a new state flag or state seal: "The commission may solicit and secure the voluntary service and aid of vexillologists and other persons who have either technical or artistic skill in flag construction and design, or the design of official seals, to assist in the work." (section 1, subdivision 4)

### **Assumptions**

The bill requires the Minnesota Historical Society to provide "administrative support" which is construed to mean assisting the commission with organizing background and other information relating to the project, as well as scheduling meetings, assembling meeting materials, keeping meeting notes and research files. As mentioned above, since the bill language contemplates having volunteer vexillologists and technical and design experts carry out design work for the state seal and state flag, and since the MNHS does not have this area of expertise on its staff, the MNHS would not be responsible for this aspect of the commission's work. The MNHS is estimating that administrative duties related to the commission could be carried out by one full time equivalent for the five months between when various entities must make their appointments and the due date of the commission's report. MNHS would absorb the costs of office space for this function.

## **Bill Description**

The bill establishes a State Emblems Redesign Commission to develop, design and recommend to the legislature and the governor new designs for the official state flag and official state seal. The commission will consist of 12 members (eight public members, two representatives and two senators). Member appointments must be made by August 1, 2023.

The Minnesota Historical Society (MHS) must provide office space and administrative support to the commission. The commission must solicit public feedback and suggestions as a part of its work. The commission must report its recommendations no later than January 1, 2024. The commission expires upon submission of its report. The legislature would vote on adoption during the 2024 legislative session.

#### **Assumptions**

- 1. The commission will meet eight times during FY24. All meetings will occur during the legislative interim.
- Four of the meetings will be held in a public space within the Twin Cities Metro area. One meeting will be held in a public space located in each of the following locations: Northeast Minnesota, Central/Northwest Minnesota, Southwest Minnesota, and Southeast Minnesota.
- 3. The bill does not provide for payment of per diems or for the reimbursement of expenses of legislators serving on the commission; however, members could request reimbursement from the House and Senate for expenses of engaging in legislative activity. This fiscal note is based on the assumption that the legislative members will be paid per diems and seek reimbursement for their expenses from the House and Senate and new funds will be needed by the House and Senate.
- 4. Legislative member meeting participation costs includes the following per member, per legislative interim meeting: per diem (\$86 senators, \$66 representatives), and \$99.56 round trip mileage (152 round trip mile average). For the four meetings that will be held in the Twin Cities Metro area, half of the legislative members will be reimbursed for lodging expenses (\$150/night senators, \$175/night representatives). For the four meetings that will be held in greater Minnesota areas, all the legislative members will be reimbursed for lodging expenses (\$150/night senators, \$175/night representatives).
- 5. The public member meeting participation cost and any meeting room rental and/or equipment cost will be addressed in the MHS's fiscal note.
- 6. This note assumes commission staff support cost will be addressed in the MHS's fiscal note.
