OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS

WHAT WE NEED

The Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) requests deficiency funding of \$196,000 in FY 2023 from the General Fund to maintain fair, timely, and impartial hearings in campaign and data practices matters.

BACKGROUND


Direct-appropriated resources from the general fund provide for OAH hearings related to data practices and campaign matters.


Individuals may file a Data Practices complaint with OAH if a Minnesota state government agency refuses access to public government data under the Government Data Practices Act.

Individuals may file a complaint with OAH alleging violations of the Fair Campaign Practices and Finance Acts. These complaints are heard by a panel of three Administrative Law Judges.

PROBLEM

Due to a record high volume of cases, the FY2023 funding for these matters depleted quickly.





In November 2022, the legislature transferred \$125,000 from the General Fund Contingent Account to OAH to maintain court services in these areas. The transfer was intended to cover costs temporarily. The contingency funding is now depleted.
