SF 833 amends the municipal rights, duties, and powers chapter of law by creating a new section of law authorizing a city or town to adopt an ordinance requiring hotels, as defined in chapter 327, to have a valid license. The annual license fee may not exceed \$150. An ordinance is limited to requirements under state and local law, and the city or town may refuse to issue a license or may revoke a license for failure to comply.
