[471.585] MUNICIPAL HOTEL LICENSING. 1.6 (a) A statutory or home rule charter city or a town may adopt an ordinance requiring 1.7 hotels operating within the boundaries of the city or town to have a valid license issued by 1.8 the city or town. 1.9 (b) An ordinance adopted under this section is limited to requiring compliance with state 1.10 and local laws as a condition of licensure. No other licensing conditions or requirements 1.11 are permitted. 1.12 (c) A city or town that has adopted an ordinance under this section may refuse to issue 1.13 a license, or may revoke an existing license, if the hotel fails to comply with the conditions 1.14 of the license. 1.15 (d) This section applies to a city or town under the jurisdiction of a community health

board. A city or town that is not under the jurisdiction of a community health board may

adopt a hotel licensing ordinance with any requirements otherwise permitted by law.
