BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

A bill for an act

- Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 128C.01, subdivision 4, is amended to read: 1.5
- Subd. 4. **Board.** (a) The league must have at least a 20-member governing board. 1.6
- (1) The governor must appoint four members according to section 15.0597. Each of the 1.7 four appointees must be a parent. At least one of them must be an American Indian, an 1.8 Asian, a Black, or a Hispanic. 1.9
- (2) The Minnesota Association of Secondary School Principals must appoint two of its 1.10 members. 1.11
- (3) The remaining 14 members must be selected according to league bylaws the league's 1.12 constitution. 1.13
 - (b) The terms, compensation, removal of members, and the filling of membership vacancies are governed by section 15.0575, except that the four-year terms begin on August 1 and end on July 31. As provided by section 15.0575, members who are full-time state employees or full-time employees of school districts or other political subdivisions of the state may not receive any per diem payment for service on the board.
