1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 383B.32, subdivision 2, is amended to read:
1.6	Subd. 2. Unclassified service. (a) The unclassified service comprises:
1.7	(1) officers chosen by election or appointment to fill an elective office;
1.8	(2) members of boards and commissions appointed by the county board;
1.9	(3) physicians, medical residents, interns, and students in training;
1.10	(4) nonsalaried attending medical staff;
1.11	(5) special sheriff's deputies serving without pay;
1.12	(6) seasonal, temporary, provisional, intermittent, and emergency positions;
1.13	(7) positions funded by specific governmental or nongovernmental grants of intermittent
1.14	or limited funding duration;
1.15	(8) the director or principal administrative officer of a department appointed pursuant
1.16	to sections 383B.101 to 383B.103; or appointed by the county board; or appointed for a
1.17	term pursuant to law;
1.18	(9) chief deputy or principal assistant and secretary for each elected official;
1.19	(10) examiner of titles and deputy examiners;

2.1	(11) chief criminal public safety services deputy sheriff, a chief civil adult detention and
2.2	court services deputy sheriff, a chief administrative deputy sheriff, and a chief financial
2.3	services community relations deputy sheriff, and a chief investigations deputy sheriff;
2.4	(12) public defender;
2.5	(13) county medical examiner;
2.6	(14) office staff appointed by the county administrator pursuant to sections 383B.101
2.7	to 383B.103; and
2.8	(15) county administrator.
2.9	(b) Notwithstanding any contrary provision of other law, any person coming within
2.10	paragraph (a), clause (8), who, on August 1, 2000, is in the classified service, remains in
2.11	the classified service until vacating the position. After that, an appointee to a position
2.12	described in paragraph (a), clause (8), is in the unclassified service.
