- Medical Monitoring

Many businesses have taken the initiative to make products safer, more sustainable and free from harmful chemicals, including the class of chemicals known as PFAS. Listening to the demands of consumers and governments, these manufacturers and retailers have found that making and selling products without harmful chemicals is both safer and profitable. There are safer alternatives available in the marketplace and passage of these pieces of legislation can help further drive the innovation opportunities and restore confidence in business as a provider of safer healthier products.

*Responsible manufacturers and retailers have adopted alternatives to PFAS, per- and poly-fluoroalkyl substances used to greaseproof, stainproof or waterproof consumer products, including cookware, apparel, furniture, carpeting and food packaging.*
