

1.1 **Senator Murphy from the Committee on State and Local Government and Veterans,**  
1.2 **to which was re-referred**

1.3 **S.F. No. 168:** A bill for an act relating to health; prohibiting excessive price increases  
1.4 by manufacturers to generic or off-patent drugs; authorizing the attorney general to take  
1.5 action against manufacturers for certain price increases; prohibiting withdrawal of certain  
1.6 generic or off-patent drugs sales; establishing a prescription drug affordability board and  
1.7 prescription drug affordability advisory council; providing for prescription drug cost reviews  
1.8 and remedies; providing appointments; imposing civil penalties; requiring a report;  
1.9 appropriating money; amending Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 151.071, subdivisions 1,  
1.10 2; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 62J.

1.11 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.12 Page 8, line 9, delete "a 17-member" and insert "an 18-member"


1.13 Page 8, line 30, delete "and"

1.14 Page 9, line 1, delete the period and insert "; and"

1.15 Page 9, after line 1, insert:

1.16 "(15) one member who is an oncologist that is not employed by, under contract with, or  
1.17 otherwise affiliated with, a hospital."

1.18 And when so amended the bill do pass and be re-referred to the Committee on Judiciary  
1.19 and Public Safety. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
