1.3 **S.F. No. 1334:** A bill for an act relating to corrections; authorizing e-filing of disposition
1.4 of detainees; providing language access to limited English proficient individuals under
1.5 authority of Department of Corrections; authorizing commissioner of corrections to determine
1.6 facility placement of juveniles sentenced as adults; amending statutory language regarding
1.7 substance use disorder assessment process to reflect current standards of care; including
1.8 warrant authority for inmate failing to report post sentencing; modifying intensive supervised
1.9 release and electronic surveillance; providing for release during a pandemic; allowing
1.10 readmission to challenge incarceration program; clarifying that Shakopee correctional
1.11 facility offers challenge incarceration program; combining Advisory council of Interstate
1.12 Adult Supervision with Interstate Commission for Juveniles; repealing intensive community
1.13 supervision program law; including community supervision agents as public safety officers
1.14 for line of duty death benefits; providing mechanism for funding probation services resulting
1.15 from transition of services to Department of Corrections; amending Minnesota Statutes
1.16 2022, sections 169A.276, subdivision 1; 241.021, by adding a subdivision; 242.18; 243.1606;
1.17 243.58; 244.05, subdivisions 6, 8; 244.0513, subdivisions 2, 4; 244.171, subdivision 4;
1.18 244.172, subdivision 1; 244.19, subdivisions 1, 5; 260.515; 299A.41, subdivision 4; 629.292,
1.19 subdivision 2; repealing Minnesota Statutes 2022, sections 244.14; 244.15.

1.20 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill do pass and be re-referred
1.21 to the Committee on Finance. Report adopted.
