
To Whom It May Concern,

I am writing this letter to show my support of the House Bill "Freedom for all to drive document", regarding Minnesota driver's license and identification cards. I am aware that this bill has the potential to allow people with no immigration status in the U.S. to obtain a Minnesota driver's license and/or identification card. To allow people to obtain current identification or driver's license will only make the state safer and make the jobs that we do as law enforcement easier.
