1.12 by adding subdivisions; 211B.32, subdivision 1; 609.165, subdivision 1; proposing coding  
1.13 for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapters 201; 204B; 211B; 243.

1.14 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill do pass and be re-referred  
1.15 to the Committee on Health and Human Services. Report adopted.
