

1.1 **Senator Dibble from the Committee on Transportation, to which was referred**

1.2 **S.F. No. 1336:** A bill for an act relating to public safety; making various policy changes,
1.3 including to veterans' license plates, dealer licenses and records, USDOT numbers, and
1.4 driver's license applications; amending Minnesota Statutes 2022, sections 168.1235,
1.5 subdivision 1; 168.1253, subdivision 3; 168.185; 168.27, subdivisions 11, 16; 168A.11,
1.6 subdivision 3; 169A.60, subdivision 13; 171.06, subdivision 3, by adding a subdivision;
1.7 171.0605, subdivisions 3, 5; 171.12, by adding a subdivision; repealing Minnesota Statutes
1.8 2022, sections 168.345, subdivision 1; 171.06, subdivision 3a.

1.9 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.10 Page 3, line 25, after "has" insert "intentionally"

1.11 Page 5, lines 2, 4, 8, and 9, strike "shall" and insert "must"

1.12 And when so amended the bill do pass. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
