S.F. No. 1053 – Metropolitan Council Authority for Fare Programs and Passes

Section 1 provides that the Metropolitan Council may establish transit fare programs and passes consistent with the fare policy purposes set forth in Minn. Stat. §473.408, subdivision 2. The programs may include (1) discount pass programs for public and private employers, public and private organizations, and school districts; and (2) special pass programs for demonstration projects or special events.

Section 2 repeals certain fare pass programs set forth in Minn. Stat. §473.408, subdivisions 6, 7, 8, and 9.

Section 3 provides that this act is effective the day following final enactment and applies to the 7-county metropolitan area.
