

1.1 **Senator Dibble from the Committee on Transportation, to which was referred**

1.2 **S.F. No. 625:** A bill for an act relating to transportation; expanding impounded vehicle
1.3 charges to include recovery and storage of a motor vehicle and its cargo and accident site
1.4 cleanup; amending Minnesota Statutes 2022, sections 168B.045; 168B.07, subdivision 1.

1.5 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.6 Page 1, line 16, before "The" insert "Except as provided in this subdivision,"

1.7 Page 1, line 22, after the period, insert "The registered owner of a vehicle who is homeless
1.8 or receives relief based on need, as defined in section 168B.07, subdivision 3, is not liable
1.9 for charges for recovery of cargo, storage of cargo, or accident site cleanup unless the costs
1.10 are covered by the owner's motor vehicle insurance. For purposes of this subdivision, "cargo"
1.11 means commercial goods or private property being transported by motor vehicle, as defined
1.12 in section 168A.01, subdivision 24, or trailer, as defined in section 168.002, subdivision
1.13 35."

1.14 And when so amended the bill do pass. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
