S.F. 2648 appropriates money for public access automated external defibrillators (AEDs) to be placed in state parks, public boat accesses, waysides, and school districts.

Subdivision 1 appropriates money to the commissioners of natural resources, transportation, and education to provide grants to purchase and install public access AEDs on public land. Provides where AEDs are to be located, including public boat accesses, state parks, rest areas, travel information centers, regional welcome centers, and visitor centers. Appropriates money for two AEDs for each school district.

Subdivision 2 provides limitations on grants awarded under section 1.

Subdivision 3 provides a timeline for the agencies listed in **subdivision 1** to accept and act upon applications from grant recipients.

Subdivision 4 requires a report from the agencies listed in **subdivision 1** to be submitted to the legislative committees with jurisdiction over the agency on the administration of grants provided under **section 1**.
