


1.1 **Senator Dibble from the Committee on Transportation, to which was re-referred**

1.2 **S.F. No. 2499:** A bill for an act relating to behavioral health; providing and waiving  
1.3 fees for certified birth records, identification cards, and driver's licenses for persons treated  
1.4 for substance use disorder who are eligible for medical assistance; modifying substance use  
1.5 disorder treatment plan review requirements; providing for transition follow-up counseling;  
1.6 modifying substance use disorder treatment rate and staffing requirements; requiring data  
1.7 to be provided to substance use disorder treatment providers; providing temporary rate  
1.8 increases for substance use disorder treatment providers and direct care staff; directing the  
1.9 commissioner of human services to develop recommendations on transition support services;  
1.10 requiring a report; amending Minnesota Statutes 2022, sections 144.226, by adding a  
1.11 subdivision; 171.06, by adding a subdivision; 245G.06, subdivision 3; 245G.07, by adding  
1.12 a subdivision; 254B.05, subdivision 5; 254B.051; 254B.12, by adding subdivisions; proposing  
1.13 coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 144.

1.14 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.15 Page 3, line 10, delete "8" and insert "12"

1.16 And when so amended the bill do pass and be re-referred to the Committee on Human  
1.17 Services. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
