1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to state government; appropriating money in the data security account;  
1.3 amending Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 3.9741, subdivision 5.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 3.9741, subdivision 5, is amended to read:

1.6 Subd. 5. **State Data security; account; appropriation.** ~~(a)~~ The data security account  
1.7 is created in the special revenue fund. Receipts credited to the account are appropriated to  
1.8 the legislative auditor.

1.9 ~~(b) Subject to available funds appropriated under paragraph (a), the legislative auditor~~  
1.10 ~~shall:~~

1.11 ~~(1) review and audit the audit reports of subscribers and requesters submitted under~~  
1.12 ~~section 168.327, subdivision 6, including producing findings and opinions;~~

1.13 ~~(2) in collaboration with the commissioner and affected subscribers and requesters,~~  
1.14 ~~recommend corrective action plans to remediate any deficiencies identified under clause~~  
1.15 ~~(1); and~~

1.16 ~~(3) review and audit driver records subscription services and bulk data practices of the~~  
1.17 ~~Department of Public Safety, including identifying any deficiencies and making~~  
1.18 ~~recommendations to the commissioner.~~

1.19 ~~(e) The legislative auditor shall submit any reports, findings, and recommendations~~
