

1.1 **Senator Dibble from the Committee on Transportation, to which was referred**

1.2 **S.F. No. 1132:** A bill for an act relating to transportation; authorizing electric vehicle
1.3 infrastructure program; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 174.

1.4 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.5 Page 1, after line 5, insert:

1.6 "Subdivision 1. **Definitions.** (a) For purposes of this section, the following terms have
1.7 the meanings given.

1.8 (b) "Commissioner" means the commissioner of transportation.

1.9 (c) "Program" means the electric vehicle infrastructure program established in this
1.10 section.

1.11 (d) "Project" includes but is not limited to planning, predesign, design, preliminary and
1.12 final engineering, environmental analysis, property acquisition, construction, and
1.13 maintenance."

1.14 Page 1, line 6, delete "of"

1.15 Page 1, line 7, delete "transportation shall" and insert "must"

1.16 Page 1, after line 14, insert:

1.17 "Subd. 4. **Program requirements.** (a) The commissioner must require that electric
1.18 vehicle infrastructure funded under the program is constructed, installed, and maintained
1.19 in conformance with the requirements under Code of Federal Regulations, title 23, section
1.20 680.106, paragraph (j), or successor requirements.

1.21 (b) An electric vehicle infrastructure project that receives funds under the program is
1.22 subject to the requirement of paying the prevailing wage rate as defined in section 177.42,
1.23 and the requirements and enforcement provisions in sections 177.27, 177.30, 177.32, 177.41
1.24 to 177.435, and 177.45.

1.25 Subd. 5. **Report.** (a) Every even-numbered year by February 1, the commissioner must
1.26 submit a report to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees
1.27 with jurisdiction over transportation policy and finance regarding the electric vehicle
1.28 infrastructure program. At a minimum, the report must include:

1.29 (1) an itemization of federal funds spent for the program, including the purpose of the
1.30 expenditure and the recipient of the expenditure;

1.31 (2) an itemization of state funds spent for the program, including the purpose of the
1.32 expenditure and the recipient of the expenditure;

2.1 (3) the amount of funds, from any source, that was used for department staff related to
2.2 the program;

2.3 (4) any changes to the plan that were made since the previous report was submitted;

2.4 (5) the locations of electric vehicle infrastructure created with the program, including
2.5 the type of infrastructure and whether the infrastructure is on public or private property;

2.6 (6) a description of how projects were selected; and

2.7 (7) a description of how the commissioner is ensuring electric vehicle infrastructure is
2.8 regionally balanced.

2.9 (b) The commissioner is not required to submit a report pursuant to this subdivision if,
2.10 since the previous report was submitted, no funds have been spent pursuant to this section."

2.11 Renumber the subdivisions in sequence

2.12 Amend the title as follows:

2.13 Page 1, line 2, after "program" insert "; requiring a report"

2.14 And when so amended the bill do pass. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
