S.F. No. 1335 – Vehicle and School Bus Requirement Modifications

Section 1 [Inspection certificate] states that a school bus inspection certificate is valid for 12 months after the month listed on the certificate.

Section 2 [Inspection criteria] imposes a 30-day limit for transporting students if using a school bus bearing a rejection sticker.

Section 3 [Violations; penalties] imposes a gross misdemeanor penalty on a person who operates a school bus displaying a rejection sticker in violation of the law.

Section 4 [Rear view mirror] allows certain vehicles to use an alternative to a rear view mirror that reflects or displays the view to a driver.

Section 5 [Inspector certification; suspension and revocation; hearing] amends a cross reference to federal law.
