- 1.10 truck, motorcycle, or recreational vehicle;
- 1.11 (2) pays an additional fee in the amount specified for special plates under section 168.12,
- 1.12 <u>subdivision 5;</u>
- 1.13 (3) pays the registration tax as required under section 168.013;
- 1.14 (4) pays the fees required under this chapter;
- 1.15 (5) contributes a minimum of \$30 annually to the trunk highway fund; and
- 1.16 (6) complies with this chapter and rules governing registration of motor vehicles and
- 1.17 licensing of drivers.
- 1.18 Subd. 2. Design. The commissioner must adopt a suitable plate design that includes a
- 1.19 black background with white text.
- 1.20 Subd. 3. Plates transfer. On application to the commissioner and payment of a transfer
- 1.21 fee of \$5, special plates issued under this section may be transferred to another motor vehicle
- 1.22 if the subsequent vehicle is:
- 1.23 (1) qualified under subdivision 1, clause (1), to bear the special plates; and
- 1.24 (2) registered to the same individual to whom the special plates were originally issued.
- 1.25 Subd. 4. Exemption. Special plates issued under this section are not subject to section
- 1.26 <u>168.1293</u>, subdivision 2.
- 1.27 <u>Subd. 5.</u> Contributions; account. Contributions collected under subdivision 1, clause
