- 1.12 (1) personal or family medical reasons;
- 1.13 (2) medical reasons of a relative; or

- (d) Applicants shall apply to the commissioner for the license on forms prescribed by
 the commissioner. The application shall must be accompanied by written verified statements
 by from the applicant's parent or guardian and by relative or a doctor setting forth the
 necessity reason the applicant is qualified for the license. The commissioner in issuing such
 license may impose such conditions and limitations as in the commissioner's judgment are
 necessary to the interests of the public safety and welfare.
- 1.26 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective July 1, 2024, and applies to applications
 1.27 submitted on or after that date. "
