

1.1 Senator moves to amend S.F. No. 1369 as follows:

1.2 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

1.3 "Section 1. **RECONSTRUCTION OF THE INTERCHANGE AT TRUNK HIGHWAY**
1.4 **13 AND NICOLLET AVENUE; BURNSVILLE.**

1.5 Subdivision 1. **Appropriation; general obligation bonds.** \$3,900,000 is appropriated
1.6 from the bond proceeds fund to the commissioner of transportation for a grant to the city
1.7 of Burnsville for predesign, right-of-way acquisition, design, engineering, and construction
1.8 of grade separation and other capacity and safety improvements to the interchange at marked
1.9 Trunk Highway 13 and Nicollet Avenue in Burnsville. This appropriation is for the portion
1.10 of the project that is eligible for use of general obligation bonds.

1.11 Subd. 2. **Appropriation; trunk highway bonds.** \$25,000,000 is appropriated from the
1.12 bond proceeds account in the trunk highway fund to the commissioner of transportation for
1.13 a grant to the city of Burnsville for predesign, right-of-way acquisition, design, engineering,
1.14 and construction of grade separation and other capacity and safety improvements to the
1.15 interchange at marked Trunk Highway 13 and Nicollet Avenue in Burnsville. The
1.16 improvements include accommodations for bicycles and pedestrians and public utility
1.17 relocations. This appropriation is for the portion of the project that is eligible for use of
1.18 trunk highway funds.

1.19 Subd. 3. **Bond sale; general obligation bonds.** To provide the money appropriated in
1.20 subdivision 1 from the bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget
1.21 shall sell and issue bonds of the state in an amount up to \$3,900,000 in the manner, upon
1.22 the terms, and with the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675,
1.23 and by the Minnesota Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.24 Subd. 4. **Bond sale; trunk highway bonds.** To provide the money appropriated in
1.25 subdivision 2 from the bond proceeds account in the trunk highway fund, the commissioner
1.26 of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of the state in an amount up to
1.27 \$25,000,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect prescribed by Minnesota
1.28 Statutes, sections 167.50 to 167.52, and by the Minnesota Constitution, article XIV, section
1.29 11, at the times and in the amounts requested by the commissioner of transportation. The
1.30 proceeds of the bonds, except accrued interest and any premium received from the sale of
1.31 the bonds, must be deposited in the bond proceeds account in the trunk highway fund.

1.32 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment."
