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"Sec. 2. [145.4145] USE OF AN ANESTHETIC OR ANALGESIC.

- Notwithstanding section 145.409, for abortions performed after 20 weeks gestational, a physician must administer an anesthetic or analgesic or arrange for the administration of an anesthetic or analgesic to eliminate or alleviate organic pain to the unborn child caused by the particular method of abortion to be performed if:
- (1) based on medically accurate information that is verified and supported by the weight of peer review medical research conducted in compliance with accepted scientific methods, it has been determined that an unborn child at the particular gestational age may feel pain;
- (2) it is medically appropriate for the female to be administered an anesthetic or analgesic based on her medical history; and
- (3) the female consents to the administration of the anesthetic or analgesic."
