**Section 1 (124D.165, subd. 2)** modifies who is considered to be an “eligible child” under the early learning scholarship program.

**Section 2 (Laws 2021, First Special Session chapter 7, article 14, section 21, subd. 4)** increases the monthly amount of child care stabilization base grant amounts paid to eligible child care providers.

**Section 3 (Appropriation)** appropriates \$12,250,000 in fiscal year 2023 in onetime funding from the general fund for the child care stabilization grants under Section 2.

**Section 4 (Appropriation)** appropriates \$40,000,000 in fiscal year 2023 in onetime funding from the general fund for early learning scholarships.
