

1.1 **Senator Wiklund from the Committee on Health and Human Services, to which**
1.2 **was referred**

1.3 **S.F. No. 329:** A bill for an act relating to insurance; requiring no-cost diagnostic services
1.4 and testing following a mammogram; amending Minnesota Statutes 2022, sections 62A.30,
1.5 by adding a subdivision; 256B.0631, subdivision 2; 256L.03, subdivision 5.

1.6 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.7 Page 1, after line 13, insert:

1.8 "Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 62A.30, is amended by adding a subdivision to
1.9 read:


1.10 Subd. 6. **Application.** If the application of subdivision 5 before an enrollee has met their
1.11 health plan's deductible would result in: (1) health savings account ineligibility under United
1.12 States Code, title 26, section 223; or (2) catastrophic health plan ineligibility under United
1.13 States Code, title 42, section 18022(e), then subdivision 5 shall apply to diagnostic services
1.14 or testing only after the enrollee has met their health plan's deductible.

1.15 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective January 1, 2024, and applies to health
1.16 plans offered, issued, or sold on or after that date."

1.17 Renumber the sections in sequence

1.18 Amend the title numbers accordingly

1.19 And when so amended the bill do pass and be re-referred to the Committee on Commerce
1.20 and Consumer Protection. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
