Bill Description

The bill provides an appropriation of \$7,900,000 per year in fiscal year 2024 and fiscal year 2025 to the commissioner of health for the Family Planning Special Projects grants under Minnesota Statutes, section 145.925.

Assumptions

Under this bill, MDH assumes the funding will be distributed in accordance with the current grant program per Minnesota statutes, section 145.925 and Minnesota Rules 4700.2000 4700.2500. Specifically, MDH assumes that funds must be distributed in accord with Minn. Rule 4700.2420, Subparts 2 ("Grant Allocations"), and 4 ("Contingency Funding"). Minn. Rule 4700.2410, Subpart 1 prohibits an increase to the Family Planning Hotline, with a \$100,000 funding cap which has already been met.

To distribute additional funds, MDH assumes that a new Request for Proposal (RFP) will be written and released, in response to which MDH anticipates new applications, as well as applications from current grantees to expand their programs. MDH anticipates approximately 40 grant awards, including current and new grantees.

This bill more than doubles the amount of funding as compared to current program funds. MDH assumes costs for an additional 3.0 FTE staff and program expenses beyond current administrative costs for additional grant administration, including RFP drafting, execution of grants and contracts, monitoring expenditures, processing invoices, and compliance with contract terms, and oversight of grantee activities through site visits.
