

1.1 **Senator Wiklund from the Committee on Health and Human Services, to which**  
1.2 **was re-referred**

1.3 **S.F. No. 3:** A bill for an act relating to elections; modifying provisions related to voter  
1.4 registration; absentee voting; requiring voting instructions, sample ballots, and election  
1.5 judges to be multilingual in certain situations; regulating intimidation, deceptive practices,  
1.6 and interference with voter registration and voting; campaign finance; expanding the  
1.7 definition of express advocacy; providing penalties; requiring reports; amending Minnesota  
1.8 Statutes 2022, sections 10A.01, subdivision 16a; 10A.27, subdivision 11; 13.607, by adding  
1.9 a subdivision; 201.014, by adding a subdivision; 201.054, subdivisions 1, 2; 201.061, by  
1.10 adding a subdivision; 201.071, subdivision 1; 201.091, subdivision 4; 201.161; 201.162;  
1.11 203B.04, subdivisions 1, 5; 203B.06, subdivisions 1, 3; 203B.12, by adding subdivisions;  
1.12 203B.121, subdivision 2; 204C.08, subdivision 1d; 204C.10; 211B.15, subdivisions 1, 7b,  
1.13 by adding subdivisions; 211B.32, subdivision 1; 609.165, subdivision 1; proposing coding  
1.14 for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapters 201; 204B; 211B; 243.

1.15 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.16 Page 1, after line 21, insert:

1.17 "Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 171.06, subdivision 3, is amended to read:

1.18 Subd. 3. **Contents of application; other information.** (a) An application must:

1.19 (1) state the full name, date of birth, sex, and either (i) the residence address of the  
1.20 applicant, or (ii) designated address under section 5B.05;

1.21 (2) as may be required by the commissioner, contain a description of the applicant and  
1.22 any other facts pertaining to the applicant, the applicant's driving privileges, and the  
1.23 applicant's ability to operate a motor vehicle with safety;

1.24 (3) state:

1.25 (i) the applicant's Social Security number; or

1.26 (ii) if the applicant does not have a Social Security number and is applying for a  
1.27 Minnesota identification card, instruction permit, or class D provisional or driver's license,  
1.28 that the applicant certifies that the applicant is not eligible for a Social Security number;

1.29 (4) contain a notification to the applicant of the availability of a living will/health care  
1.30 directive designation on the license under section 171.07, subdivision 7; ~~and~~

1.31 (5) include a method for the applicant to:

1.32 (i) request a veteran designation on the license under section 171.07, subdivision 15,  
1.33 and the driving record under section 171.12, subdivision 5a;

1.34 (ii) indicate a desire to make an anatomical gift under subdivision 3b, paragraph (e);

- 2.1 (iii) as applicable, designate document retention as provided under section 171.12,  
 2.2 subdivision 3c; and
- 2.3 (iv) indicate emergency contacts as provided under section 171.12, subdivision 5b; and  
 2.4 (6) meet the requirements under section 201.161, subdivision 3.
- 2.5 (b) Applications must be accompanied by satisfactory evidence demonstrating:
- 2.6 (1) identity, date of birth, and any legal name change if applicable; and
- 2.7 (2) for driver's licenses and Minnesota identification cards that meet all requirements of  
 2.8 the REAL ID Act:
- 2.9 (i) principal residence address in Minnesota, including application for a change of address,  
 2.10 unless the applicant provides a designated address under section 5B.05;
- 2.11 (ii) Social Security number, or related documentation as applicable; and
- 2.12 (iii) lawful status, as defined in Code of Federal Regulations, title 6, section 37.3.
- 2.13 (c) An application for an enhanced driver's license or enhanced identification card must  
 2.14 be accompanied by:
- 2.15 (1) satisfactory evidence demonstrating the applicant's full legal name and United States  
 2.16 citizenship; and
- 2.17 (2) a photographic identity document.
- 2.18 (d) A valid Department of Corrections or Federal Bureau of Prisons identification card  
 2.19 containing the applicant's full name, date of birth, and photograph issued to the applicant  
 2.20 is an acceptable form of proof of identity in an application for an identification card,  
 2.21 instruction permit, or driver's license as a secondary document for purposes of Minnesota  
 2.22 Rules, part 7410.0400, and successor rules."
- 2.23 Page 5, line 16, delete ", instruction permit,"
- 2.24 Page 5, line 18, after "256L" insert "or medical assistance under chapter 256B"
- 2.25 Page 5, line 27, delete everything before the second period
- 2.26 Page 5, line 29, delete "submitting the application" and insert "the date of the mailing  
 2.27 of the notice under this section"
- 2.28 Page 7, line 11, after "(a)" insert "If permitted by the federal government,"
- 2.29 Page 7, line 13, delete "any" and insert "applicants 18 years of age or older whose United  
 2.30 States citizenship has been verified as part of the application."

3.1 Page 7, delete lines 14 to 19

3.2 Page 7, line 20, delete everything before "The" and after "information" insert "required  
3.3 to register to vote, as prescribed by the secretary of state,"

3.4 Page 7, line 34, delete "December 1, 2025" and insert "one year following authorization  
3.5 from the federal government"

3.6 Page 21, line 28, delete "a" and insert "any" and delete "a" and insert "that"

3.7 Page 22, lines 27 delete "an election official" and insert "any person injured by an act  
3.8 prohibited by this section"

3.9 Page 22, line 30, delete "an election official" and insert "any person"


3.10 Page 23, line 1, delete "an election official" and insert "any person"

3.11 Page 25, line 20, delete "this paragraph" and insert "items (i) to (iv)"

3.12 Renumber the sections in sequence

3.13 Amend the title numbers accordingly

3.14 And when so amended the bill do pass and be re-referred to the Committee on Judiciary  
3.15 and Public Safety. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
