

1.1 Senator moves to amend S.F. No. 73, the 4th engrossment, as follows:

1.2 Page 17, after line 12, insert:

1.3 "(5) the commissioner of human services or a designee;"

1.4 Page 18, after line 20, insert:

1.5 "(33) two licensed mental health professionals appointed by the governor;"

1.6 Renumber the clauses in sequence

1.7 Page 107, after line 6, insert:

1.8 "(10) a warning symbol developed by the office in consultation with the commissioner
1.9 of health and the Minnesota Poison Control System that:

1.10 (i) is at least three-quarters of an inch tall and six-tenths of an inch wide;

1.11 (ii) is in a highly visible color;

1.12 (iii) includes a visual element that is commonly understood to mean a person should
1.13 stop;

1.14 (iv) indicates that the product is not for children; and

1.15 (v) includes the phone number of the Minnesota Poison Control System;"

1.16 Renumber the clauses in sequence

1.17 Page 224, after line 1, insert:

1.18 "Sec. 5. **EDIBLE CANNABINOID PRODUCTS; ENFORCEMENT.**

1.19 (a) The Department of Health shall enforce the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, section
1.20 151.72, and all rules, orders, stipulation agreements, settlements, compliance agreements,
1.21 and registrations related to that section adopted or issued by the Office of Medical Cannabis
1.22 or the Department of Health pursuant to the Health Enforcement Consolidation Act of 1993
1.23 contained in Minnesota Statutes, sections 144.989 to 144.993. The commissioner of health
1.24 may assign enforcement responsibilities to the Office of Medical Cannabis.

1.25 (b) The enforcement authority under paragraph (a) shall transfer to the Office of Cannabis
1.26 Management at any such time that the powers and duties of the Department of Health, with
1.27 respect to the medical cannabis program under Minnesota Statutes 2022, sections 152.22
1.28 to 152.37, are transferred to the Office of Cannabis Management. The director of the Office
1.29 of Cannabis Management may assign enforcement responsibilities to the Division of Medical
1.30 Cannabis.

2.1 (c) This section shall expire on July 1, 2024.

2.2 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment."

2.3 Page 247, after line 8, insert:

2.4 "Subd. 9. **Department of Health; Minnesota Poison Control System.** \$..... in fiscal
2.5 year 2024 and \$..... in fiscal year 2025 are appropriated from the general fund to the
2.6 commissioner of health to support the poison control system and award or supplement grants
2.7 pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, section 145.93."
