This bill provides an appropriation of \$260,000 per year in fiscal year 2024 and fiscal year 2025 to the commissioner of health for a grant to the Amherst H. Wilder Foundation for the African American Babies Coalition initiative. Any unexpended balance in the first year of the biennium is available in the second year of the biennium.

Assumptions
