

1.1 **Senator Wiklund from the Committee on Health and Human Services, to which**  
1.2 **was referred**

1.3 **S.F. No. 2499:** A bill for an act relating to behavioral health; providing and waiving  
1.4 fees for certified birth records, identification cards, and driver's licenses for persons treated  
1.5 for substance use disorder who are eligible for medical assistance; modifying substance use  
1.6 disorder treatment plan review requirements; providing for transition follow-up counseling;  
1.7 modifying substance use disorder treatment rate and staffing requirements; requiring data  
1.8 to be provided to substance use disorder treatment providers; providing temporary rate  
1.9 increases for substance use disorder treatment providers and direct care staff; directing the  
1.10 commissioner of human services to develop recommendations on transition support services;  
1.11 requiring a report; amending Minnesota Statutes 2022, sections 144.226, by adding a  
1.12 subdivision; 171.06, by adding a subdivision; 245G.06, subdivision 3; 245G.07, by adding  
1.13 a subdivision; 254B.05, subdivision 5; 254B.051; 254B.12, by adding subdivisions; proposing  
1.14 coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 144.


1.15 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.16 Page 4, line 1, delete "birth record" and insert "identification card or driver's license"

1.17 Page 9, line 19, delete "6" and insert "4"

1.18 Page 9, line 22, after the comma, insert "and each February 1 thereafter," and delete  
1.19 "annually"

1.20 And when so amended the bill do pass and be re-referred to the Committee on  
1.21 Transportation. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
