
## MN PMP Status of State-wide Integration Evaluating Progress

## **Prescription Monitoring Program**

all 2022 data is preliminary



With Bamboo Health's Gateway solution, an authorized MN PMP account holder can perform a search of their patient's PMP history with one-click from within their electronic health record (EHR) or pharmacy dispensing software (PDS). The searcher's credentials and patient demographic information are transmitted to the MN PMP database and the patient's PMP report is returned in 1-2 seconds within the clinical workflow!

The Board of Pharmacy, through grants received from federal government and other state agencies, began providing a state-wide license to enable integration to Minnesota clinics, hospitals, and pharmacies at no cost beginning fall of 2020.




In an effort to understand the value of this state-wide license, the program administered a survey to MN PMP account holders in December 2021.





Analysis shows that prior to the funding of a state-wide license for integrated access, prescribers and pharmacists in Minnesota were accessing primarily through the web portal. Delegates authorized by prescribers and pharmacists to search on their behalf played a significant role in accessing the PMP.

As one-click access to PMP reports began to supersede searching through the web portal, there shows a steep increase in searches performed.

This could be attributed to prescribers and pharmacists being more apt to check the PMP for their patient with expedited, quicker access.
