Dear Rep. Bierman and Sen. Xiong:

As an organization, the Coalition of Recovery Investment (CORI) and our member organizations advocate for much needed funding, reform and increased access for behavioral health illnesses such as substance use disorder (SUD).

We are writing today to support SF1490/HF1771 which would require all payers to reimburse the Psychiatric Collaborative Care Management billing codes.

Depression and other common mental disorders are common, disabling, and associated with high health care costs and substantial losses in productivity, yet only about 25 percent of patients with these disorders receive effective care.

The psychiatric collaborative care model is an evidence-based approach for integrating physical and behavioral health services that can be implemented within a primary care-based setting. The model includes:

- care coordination and care management
- regular/proactive monitoring and treatment to target using validated clinical rating scales; and
- regular, systematic psychiatric caseload reviews and consultation for patients who do not show clinical improvement.

Over 70 studies have shown this integrated model of care improves patient outcomes, save money, and reduces stigma related to mental health. This is exactly the type of innovated models we should be deploying to help Minnesotans suffering from behavioral health illnesses. We thank you for authoring SF1490/HF1771.
