Bill Description

This bill establishes a diaper distribution competitive grant program to provide diapers to under resourced families across the state. It establishes eligibility criteria for grantees, requires the commissioner to create an application program, defines the eligible uses of grant money, describes compliance activities for grantees and adds a reporting requirement.

Assumptions

This proposal will require one 0.5 FTE grant manager, classified as 14L MAPE, to run a request for proposal (RFP) program, enter into contract(s) with grantee(s), monitor grantee fidelity to program criteria, ensure the program provides resources statewide, monitor grantees for compliance with state grant management practices and write an annual legislative report.

FTEs are assumed to begin in 2024, and require an up-front administrative cost of \$17,744, and ongoing monthly administrative costs of \$2,228. Fringe benefits are estimated using the most recent union contracts. FTEs are assumed to begin in September.
