S.F. No. 1288 – Establishes the allied health technician scholarship program

Section 1 Allied Health Technician Scholarship Program

Subd 1 requires the commissioner of the office of higher education to establish a program to provide up to 1000 scholarships to students entering specified health technician programs by 2026.

Subd 2 specifies the eligibility criteria and lists the health technician fields for which the student must be enrolled to be eligible for the scholarship. A student may receive the scholarship one time.

Subd 3 requires the commissioner to establish an application process and other guidelines for implementation, and the first set of scholarships must be awarded for the 2024-2025 academic year. The scholarship amount is \$5000, paid to the institution in which the student is enrolled.

Subd 4 requires a report by February 2025 and 2026 and lists the information that must be contained in the report.

Subd 5 expires this section on June 30, 2026.

Section 2 appropriates \$5,380,000 in fiscal year 2024 for purposes of section 1. Of this amount, \$5,000,000 is for 1000 scholarships, \$230,000 is for promotion of the program and student recruitment, and \$150,000 is for administering the program. This is a onetime appropriation and is available until expended or June 30, 2026, whichever occurs first.
